Resolution 2009-12

Consideration Of The Tijuana River Valley And Estuary Goat Canyon Trash Capture And Removal System For The Solid Waste Disposal And Codisposal Site Cleanup Program (Solid Waste Disposal Trust Fund, FY 2008/09)

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Sections 48020, *et seq.* authorizes the California Integrated Waste Management Board (Board) to implement the Solid Waste Disposal and Codisposal Site Cleanup Program (Program) to remediate environmental problems caused by solid waste and clean up disposal sites to protect public health and safety and the environment where the responsible parties cannot be identified or are unable or unwilling to pay for timely remediation; and

WHEREAS, the Board has approved guidelines, policies, and regulations for the Program to clean up sites; and

WHEREAS, the estimated costs for the Tijuana River Valley And Estuary Goat Canyon Trash Capture And Removal System project is two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000); and

WHEREAS, the proposed project satisfy the Board's guidelines and policies pursuant to the Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approves the Tijuana River Valley And Estuary Goat Canyon Trash Capture And Removal System Board-managed cleanup project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board waives cost recovery against the Department of Parks and Recreation with respect to the Tijuana River Valley And Estuary Goat Canyon Trash Capture And Removal System Board-managed cleanup project.
